PLEASE NOTE:

In all cases, anyone attending for interview will be required to produce evidence of eligibility to work in the UK, this will be either:

- A) a combination of a document showing a permanent NI Number (P45/P60/National Insurance Card or letter from a government agency) plus one of the following;**
- a full UK birth certificate which includes the holder's parents' names;**
- a Channel Island or Isle of Man or Ireland birth certificate;**
- a certificate of registration or naturalisation stating a British citizen, a Home Office letter stating the person named can stay indefinitely in the UK or has no limit of their stay;**
- an Immigration Status Document issued by the Home Office indicating no time limit on stay in UK;**
- a Home Office letter indicating they can stay in the UK and this allows them to do the type of work we are offering;**
- an Immigration Status Document issued by the Home Office with an endorsement indicating the person named can stay in the UK and this allows them to do the type of work we are offering.**

OR

B) A work permit or other approval to take employment issued by Work Permits UK plus one of the following;

a passport or other travel document endorsed to show that the holder is able to stay in the UK and can take the work permit employment in question;

a Home Office letter to the holder confirming that the person named is able to stay in the UK and can take the work permit employment in question.

OR

C) Any one of the following documents:

a passport showing the holder is a British citizen or has the right of abode in the UK;

a national passport or national ID card showing the holder is a national of a European Economic Area(EEA) country or Switzerland;

a residence permit issued by the Home Office to a national from a EEA country or Switzerland;

a passport or other document issued by the Home Office which has an endorsement stating that the holder has a current right of residence in the UK as the family member of a national from a EEA country or Switzerland who is resident in the UK;

a passport or other travel document endorsed to show the holder can stay indefinitely in the UK or has not time limit on their stay;

a passport or other travel document endorsed to show that the holder can stay in the UK and this endorsement allows the holder to do the type of work we are offering if they do not have a work permit;

an Application Registration Card issued by the Home Office to an asylum seeker stating the holder is permitted to take employment
